



2020-2021 Graduate Diversity Fellowship Program

State University of New York offers a scholarship program to recruit, enroll, and retain students who will contribute to the diversity of the student body in the university's graduate and professional programs.

Eligibility: Applicants must be:

- U.S. citizens or hold permanent resident status.
- Accepted as matriculated, full-time students (registering for at least 9 graduate credits each semester) in a graduate program. OR
- Currently enrolled doctoral candidates who have completed all degree requirements but the dissertation (“ABD”).
- Students must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA each semester and making progress through their program to continue to receive funding.

How to Apply

- Diversity Essay:** Please state how you can contribute to the diversity of the student body in your program or school, primarily by demonstrating that you have overcome a disadvantage in order to achieve success in higher education. (1-2 typed pages).
- Submit 2 letters** of recommendation (one from your Dean or Department Chair) attesting to your academic ability and worthiness of this award to financialaid@downstate.edu directly. If you are a new student, you can use a prior Dean or Department Chair.
- Deadline:** Complete the application by **May 1, 2020**
