- **Students are required to complete 1 Core Yr Elective but can do 2 Core electives if they choose.*
- *Clerkships are paired in 12 week blocks*
- *Core clerkship year has built in two 1-week vacations.*

Approx. Sixteen **(16)** “Flex” weeks in Advanced Clinical Year for:

- Complete core clerkships not previously taken *(if any)*
- USMLE Step 2CK/CS study
- Residency interviews
- Extra electives
- Vacation
- Remediation of deficiencies *(if any)*

In addition to the above clinical requirements:

- Students are required to successfully pass a mandatory standardized patient experience, which is scheduled in the Feb/March of the Core Clerkship year – Gateway #3.
- Students are required to take the USMLE Step 2CK and CS examinations by November 1 of their senior year.
- Students are required to **pass** both Step 2 CK and CS as graduation requirements.
